Dear Berwick Camper, it's registration time for Berwick Camp Meeting 138.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY - the selection process for accommodation assignments are allotted with the following priorities:

1. Staff (as defined by the Program Committee; Long-service staff returning as campers are treated as # 4 below.)
2. Returning campers who have occupied the same accommodation for the past two years wishing the same accommodation.
2. Returning campers after a one-year absence.
3. Returning campers wishing different accommodation.
4. New campers (don't be discouraged, most are accommodated.)
5. Senior citizens have priority for serviced apartments until May 24th.

After May 24th, ALL accommodations are allotted on a first come-first served basis.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE REGISTRATION FORM MUST INCLUDE ALL OF THE REGISTRATION FEE IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED. PLEASE FILL IN ALL INFORMATION FOR ALL INDIVIDUALS. If new registration fees are too burdensome financial assistance is available. Please contact the Registrar for information.

The Registrar will date the registration forms as they are received. **No processing** will take place before **April 15th 2009**. Please be patient, your confirmation of accommodations will be processed as quickly as possible after that date.

If you wish to make a DONATION to the camp, please include it with your registration form.

Camp starts at supper on Friday 24 July and ends at noon on Sunday 2 August. Campers who spend the **night at camp** prior to 24 July and after Saturday August 2nd must pay the daily rate for any extra nights.

Dorm Campers please note NO BEDDING will be provided and if possible bring your own pillow. For health and safety reasons, the Executive has decided that no pets will be permitted in the Dorms or the Fireside rooms. The closeness of these accommodations makes them unsuitable for pets to be present.

Remember safety first. All who enter the campground must register at the Registrar's office. If you have a fire extinguisher, please consider bringing it to have in your accommodations. No cooking or heaters are permitted in the dorms or fireside rooms.
